



ATTENTION ANGLERS!

Spring Creek and Little White Salmon National Fish Hatcheries have recently attached disc tags and some radio transmitters to hatchery fall Chinook salmon. This assessment is an effort to determine the effect of ladder operations on hatchery brood stock collection, behavior of hatchery fall Chinook, and contributions to sport and tribal fisheries. Tagged fall Chinook salmon will have a numbered disc with tag reporting information printed on one side.



Some fish may have radio transmitters attached to one side with disc tags on the opposite side
